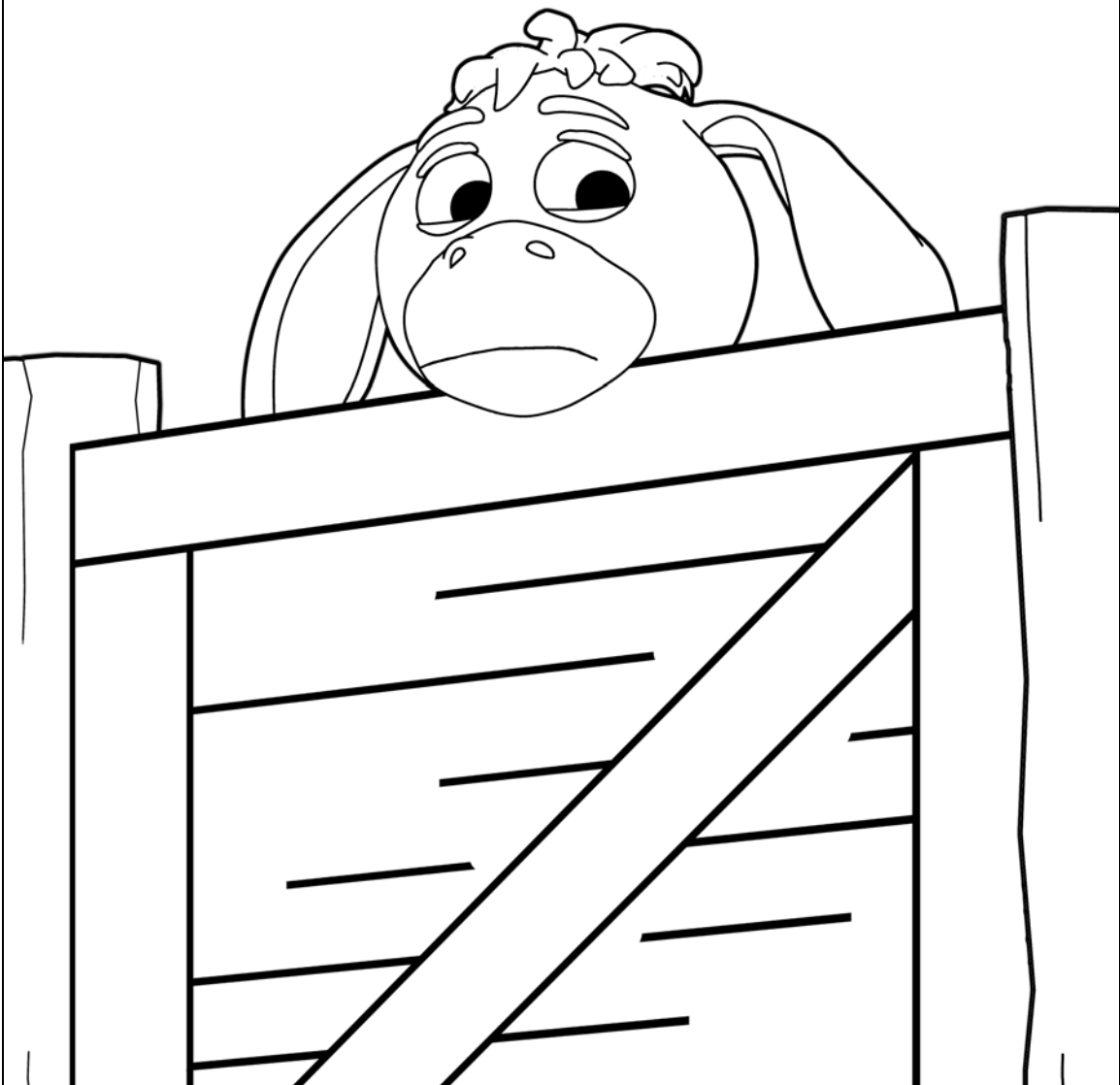


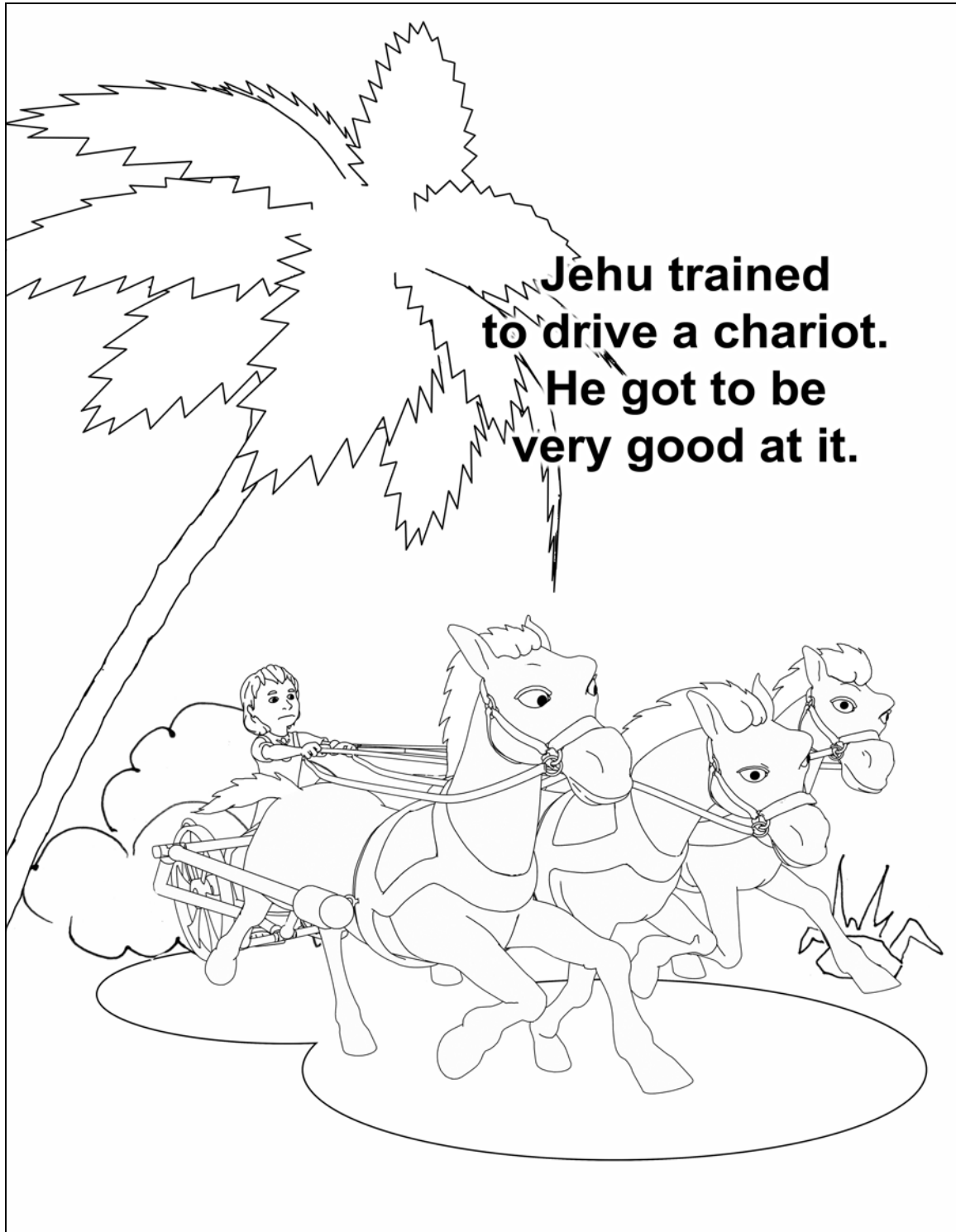




Allondra fixed Rupert's wing.

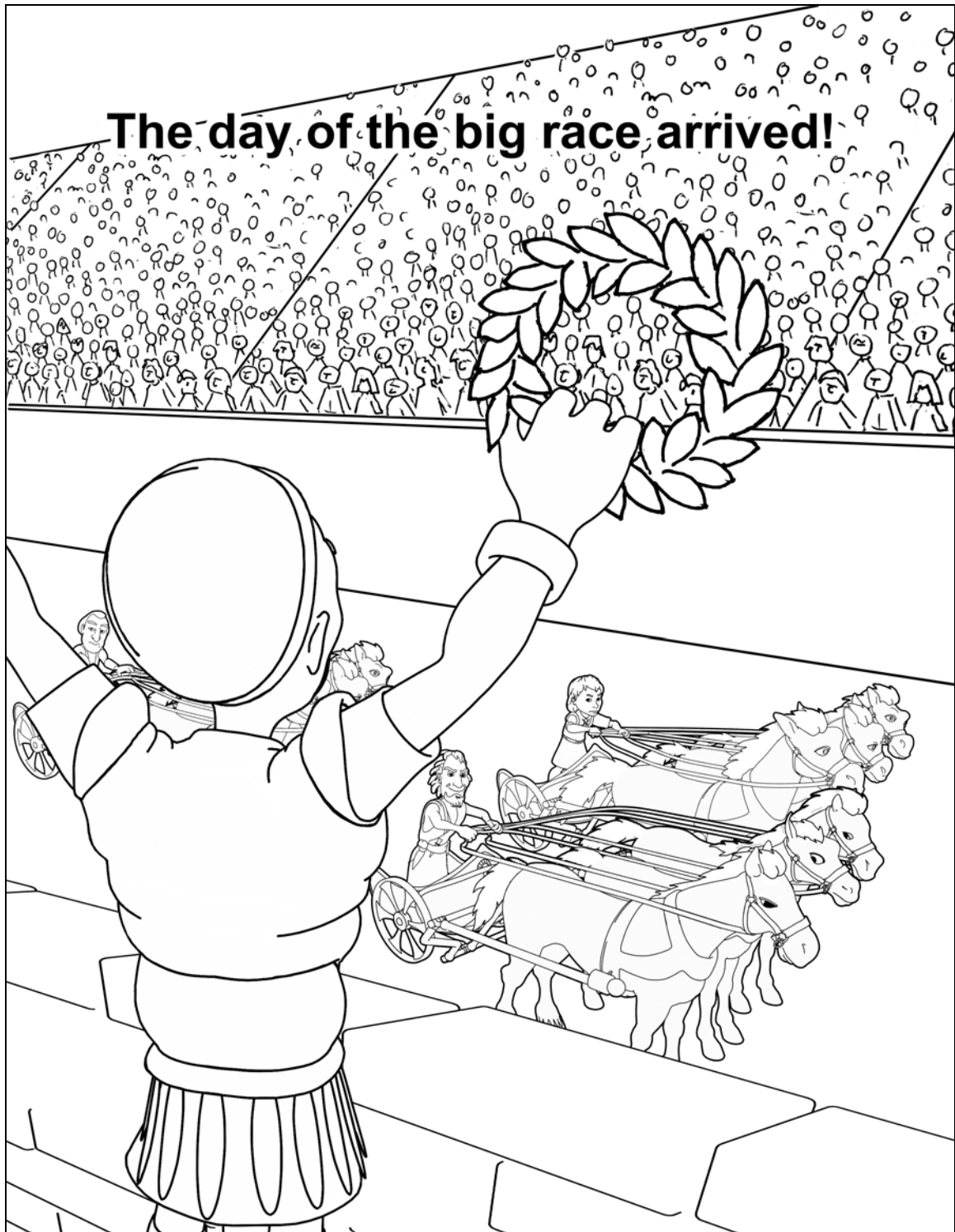

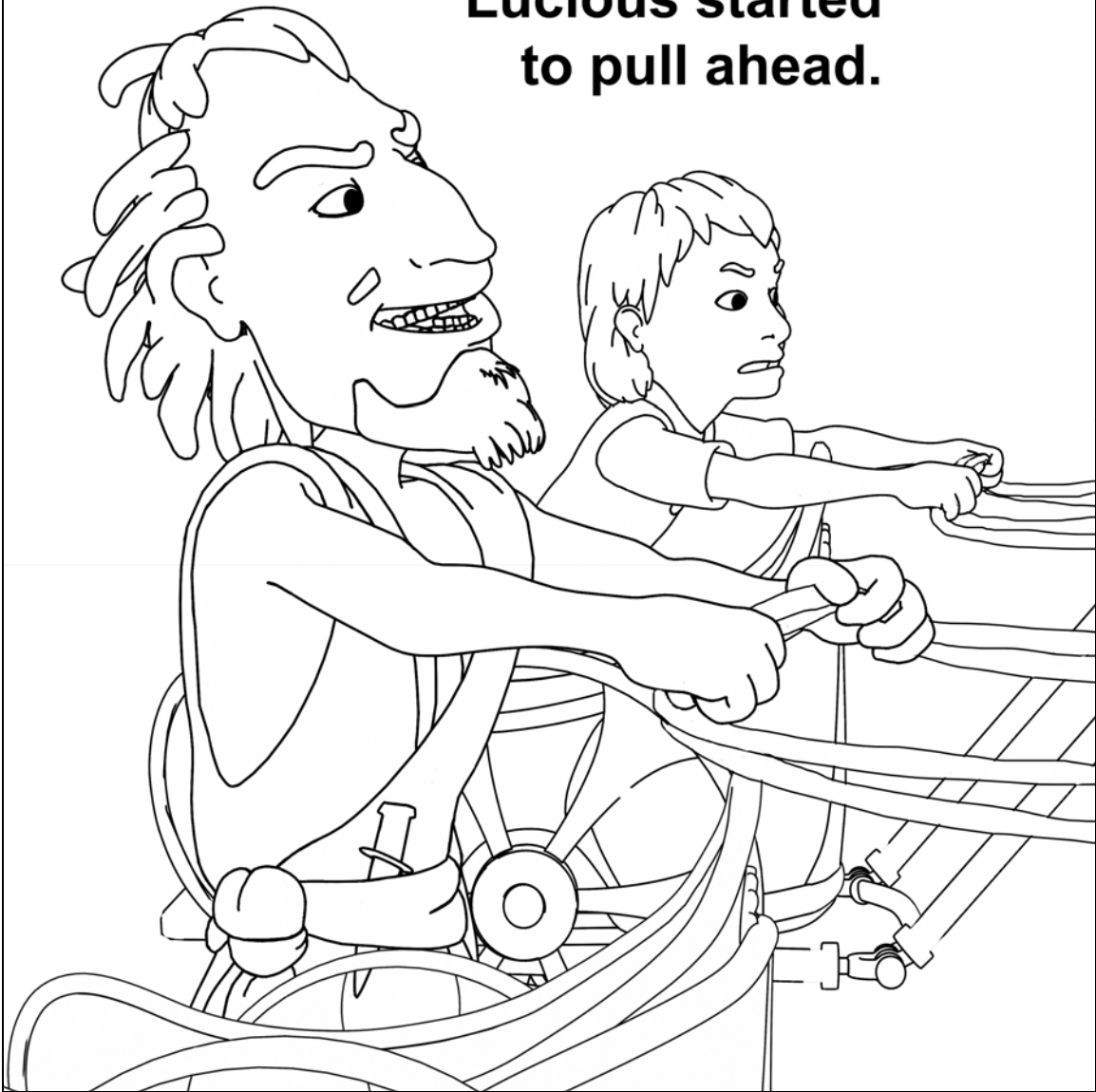






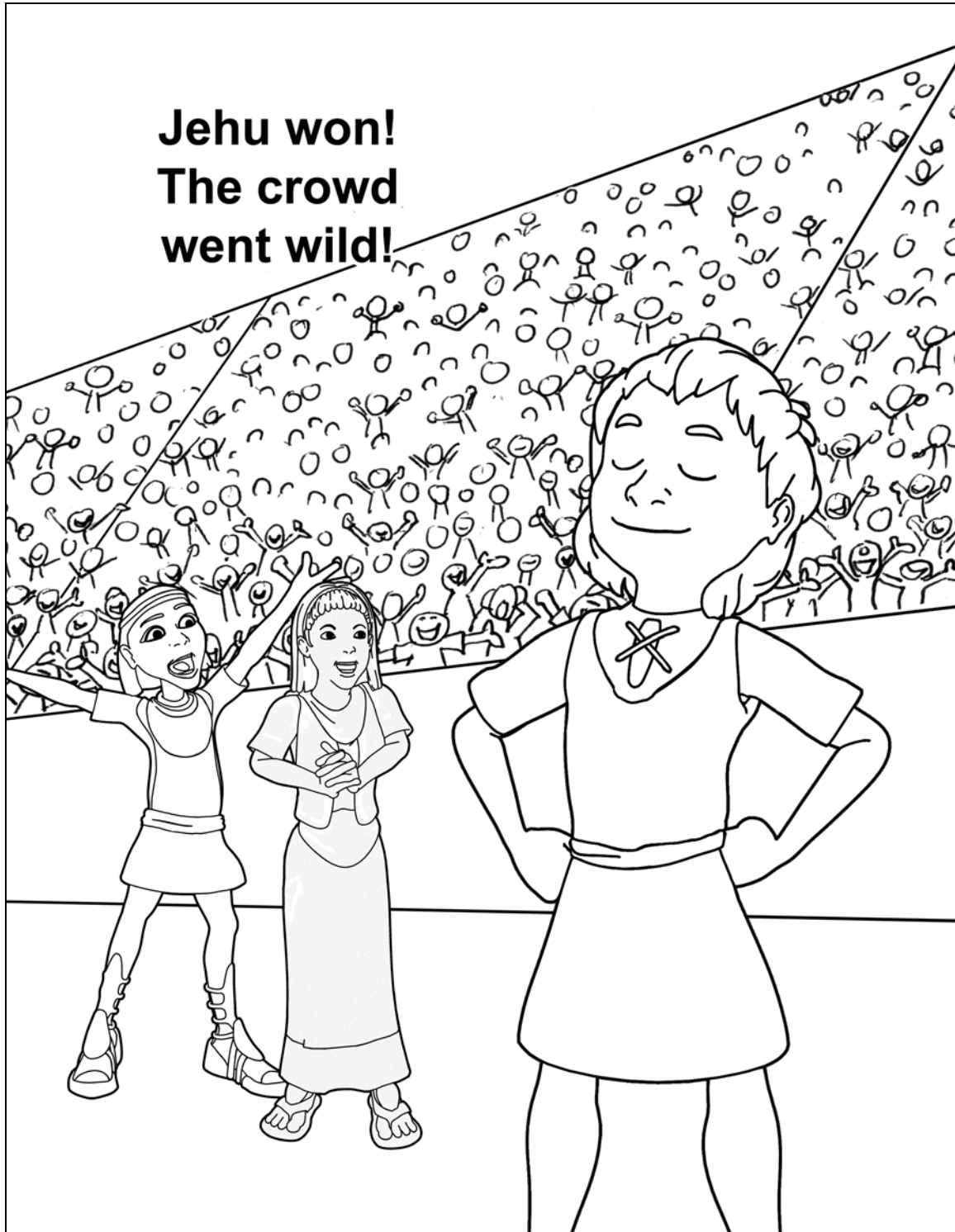
