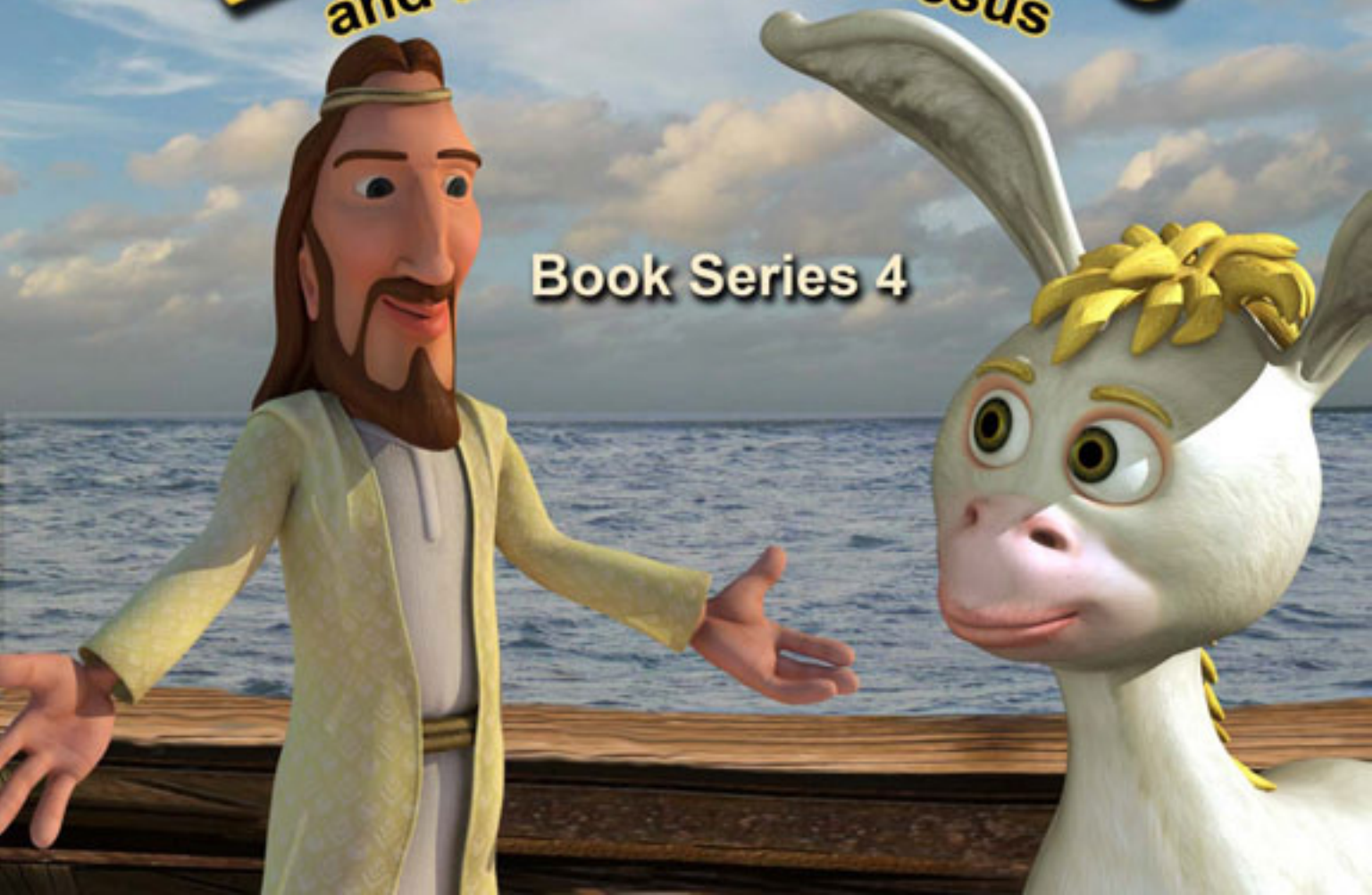

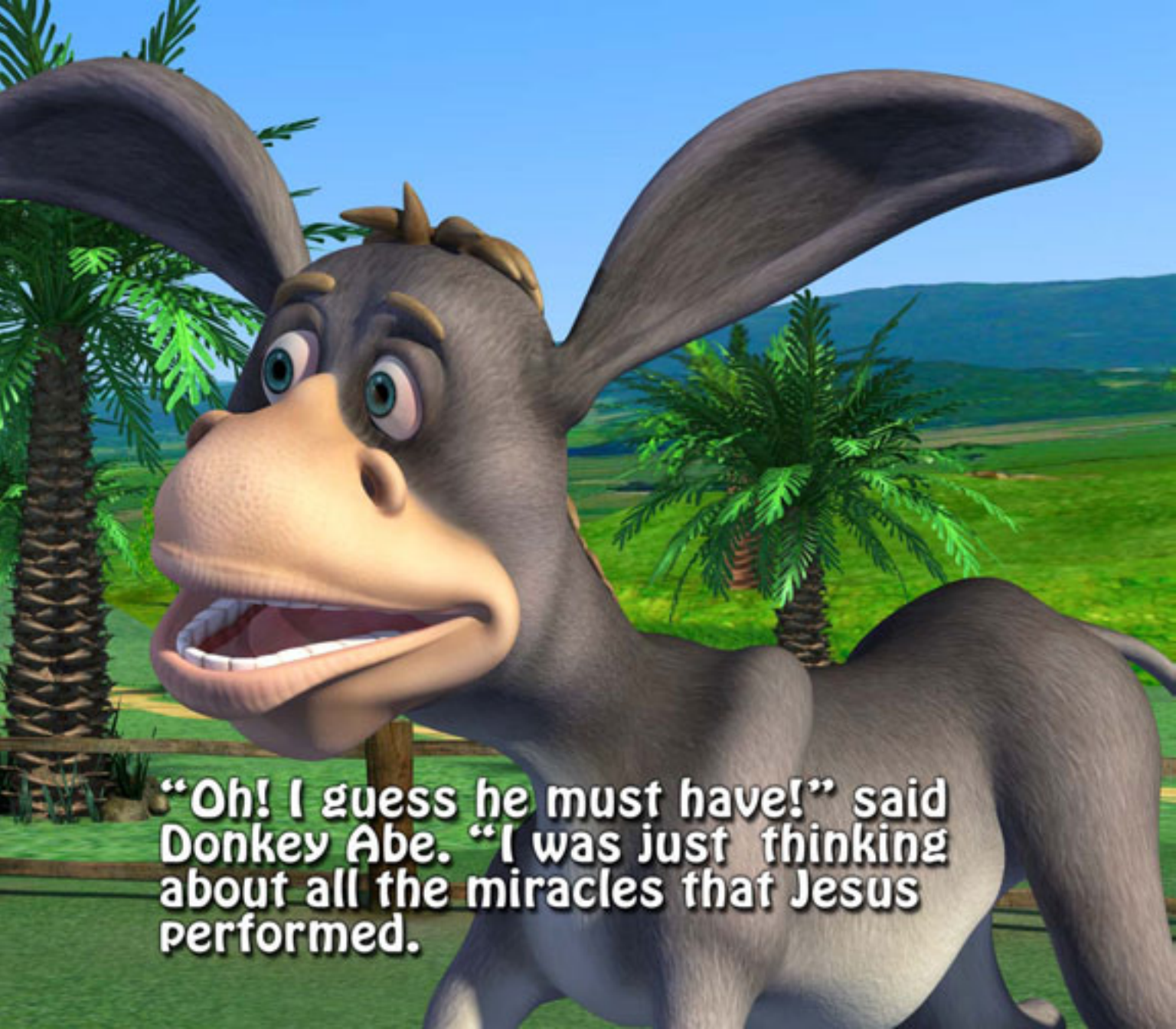


**One sunny afternoon,

**“But Abe said that Jesus performed miracles,” said Ollie.**





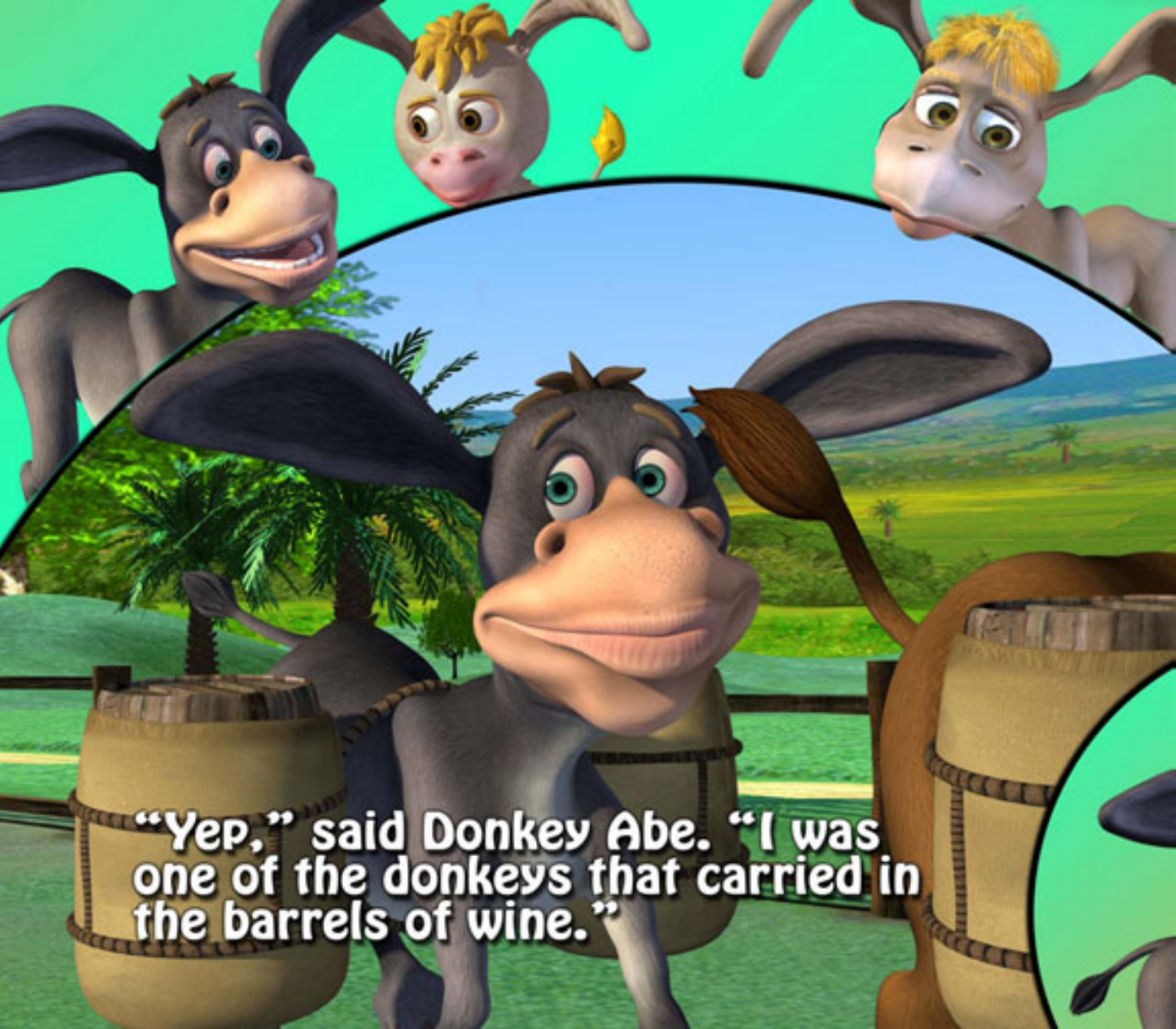
**“God gave Jesus

“but I once saw a really BIG catch!”**





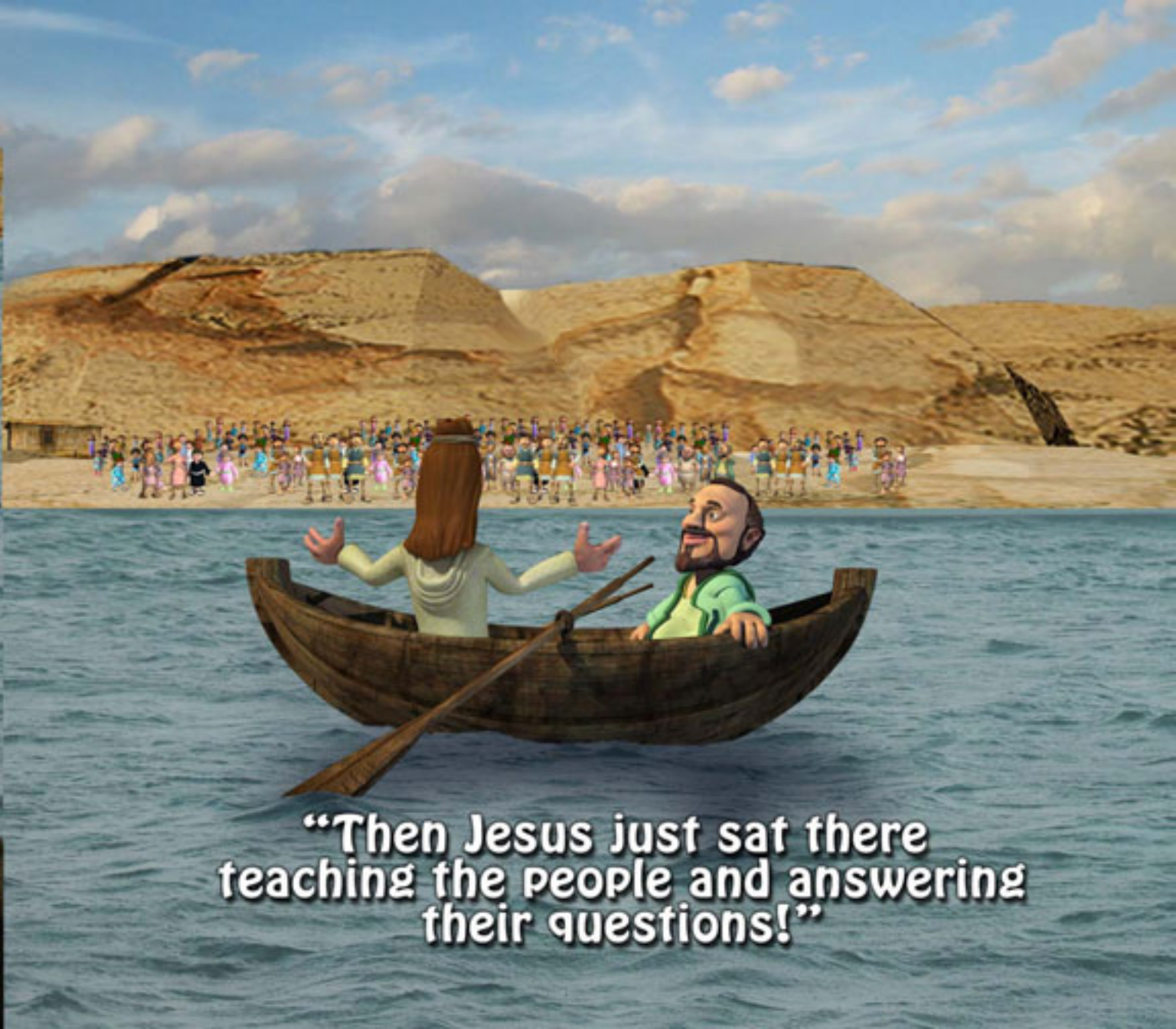
**“Oh?” asked Ollie.**

**“We’ve been fishing all night,” said Peter. “There’s nothing in this sea but water!”**


**“ ‘Try it anyway,’ said Jesus. So Peter did.”**


Ollie and his brothers

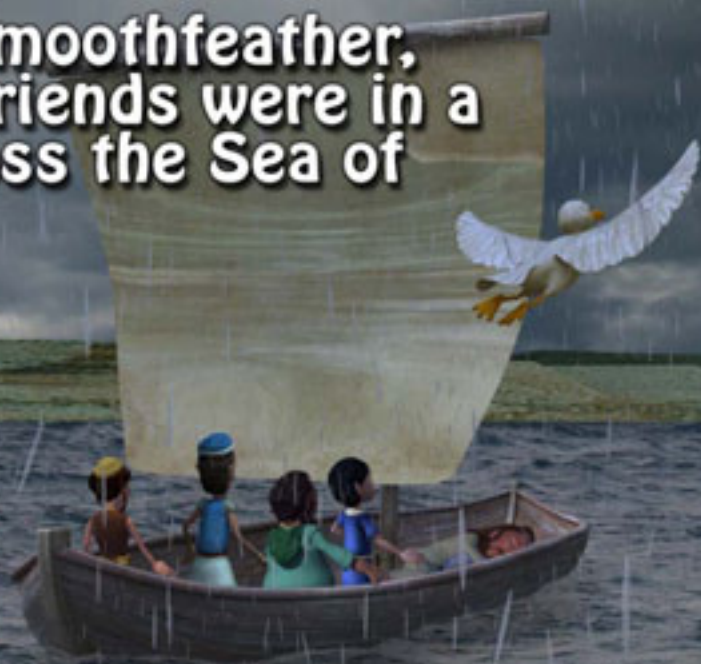

were going to sink!”**







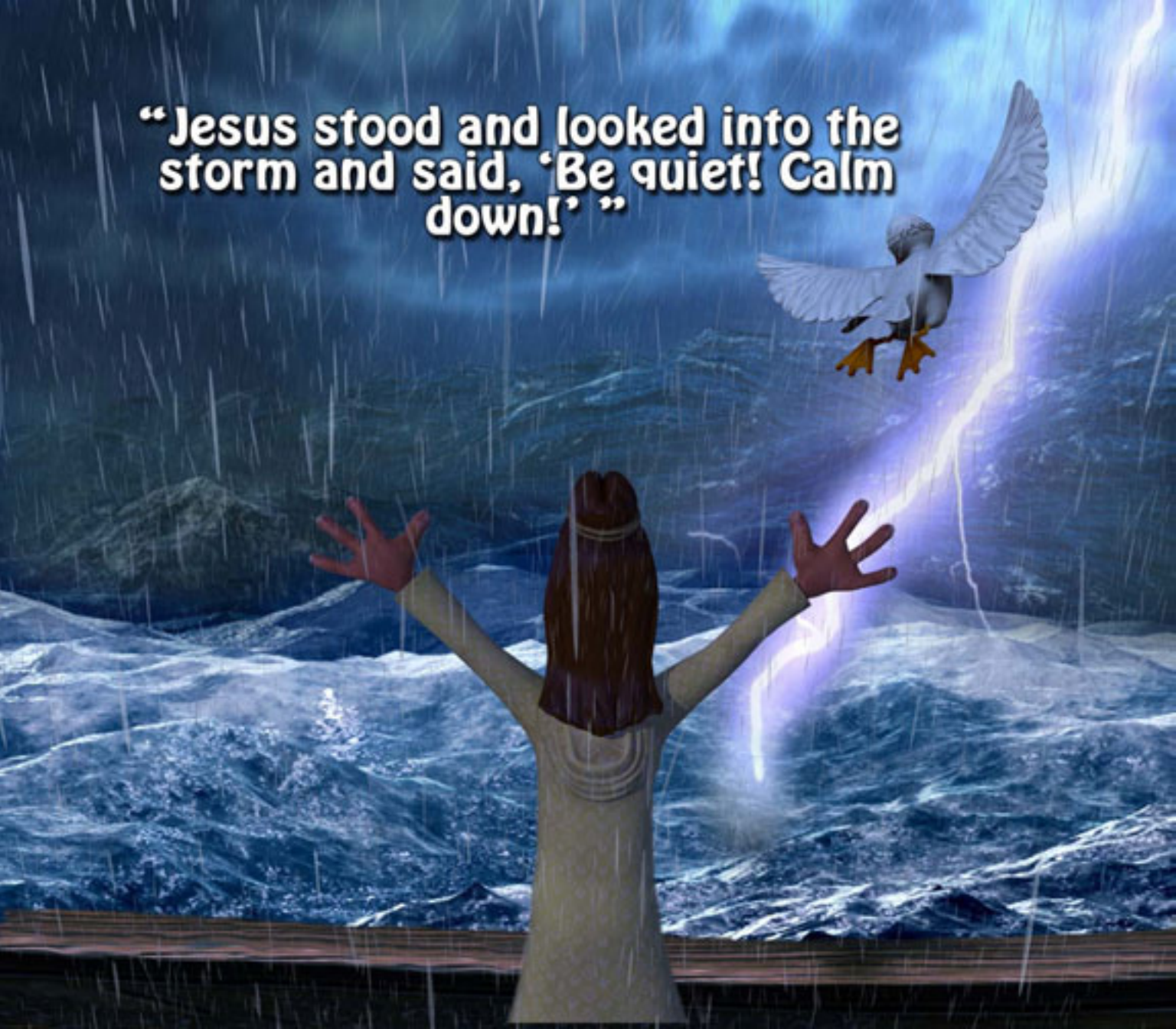
**“Finally, they woke up Jesus. ‘Master,’ they cried, ‘don’t you even care that we are about to sink?!?!’ ”**

**“Everybody laughed at him.”**

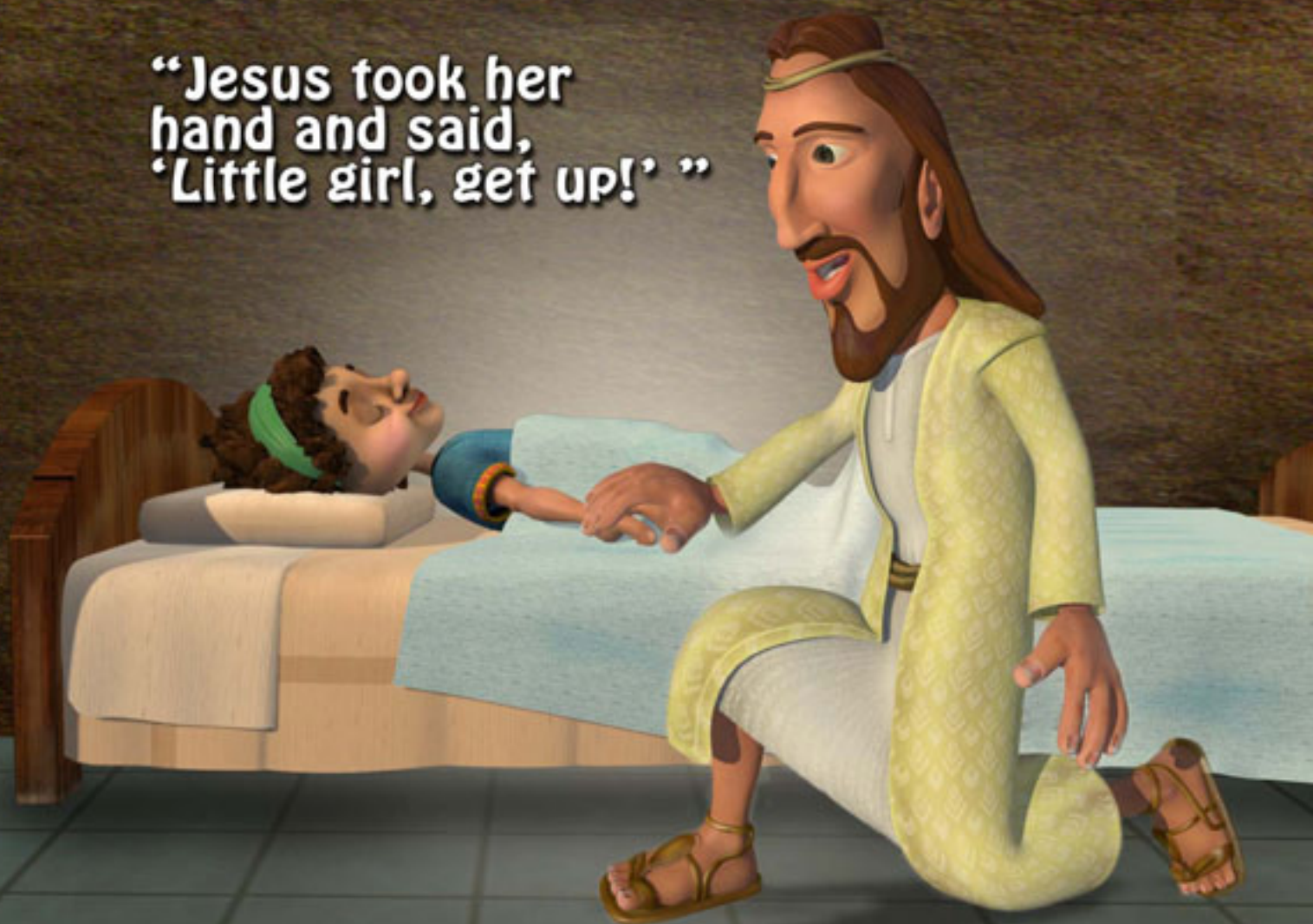


**“Jesus sent away everyone but the girls’ parents and his three disciples.”**

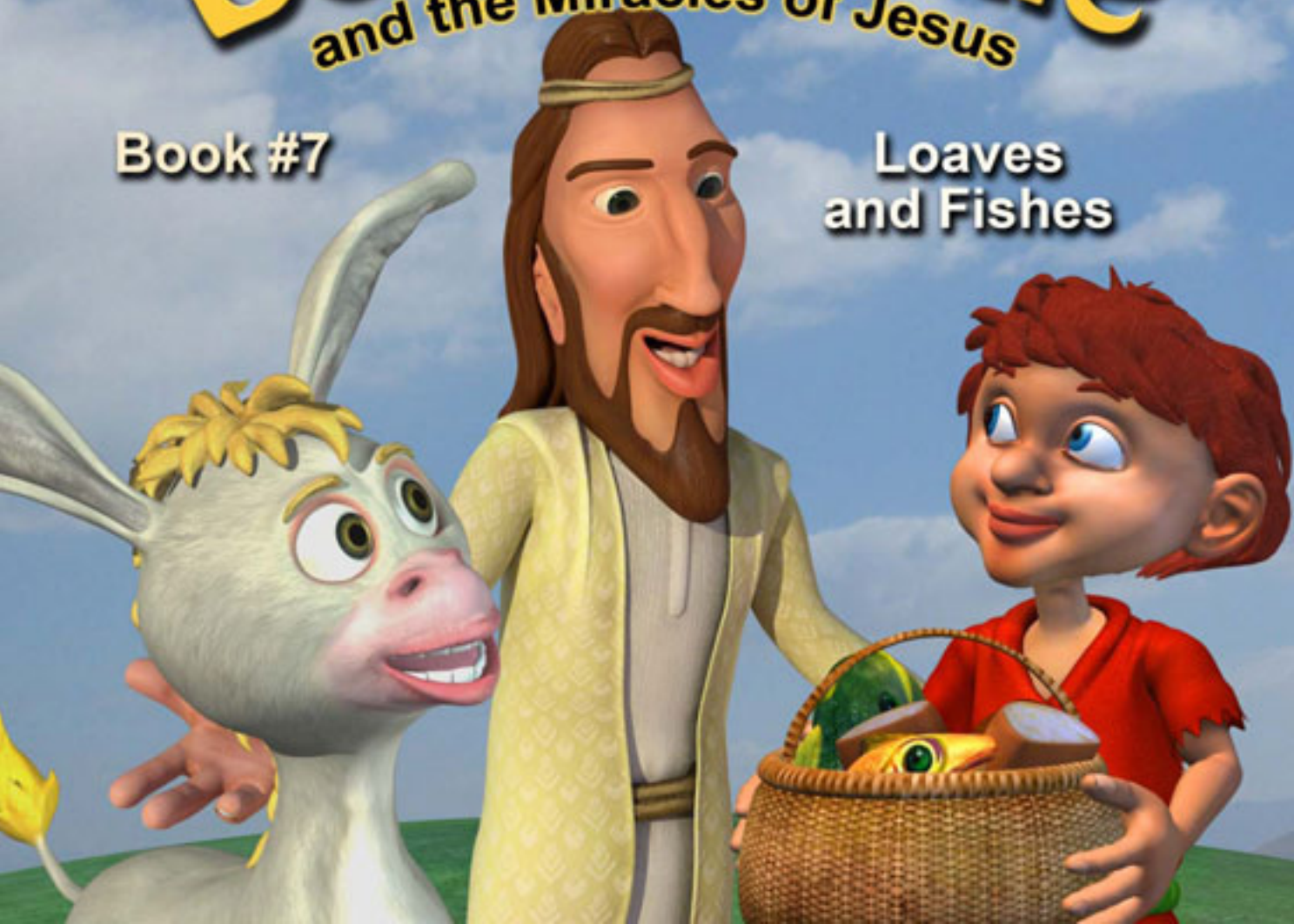

as he took a big mouthful.**





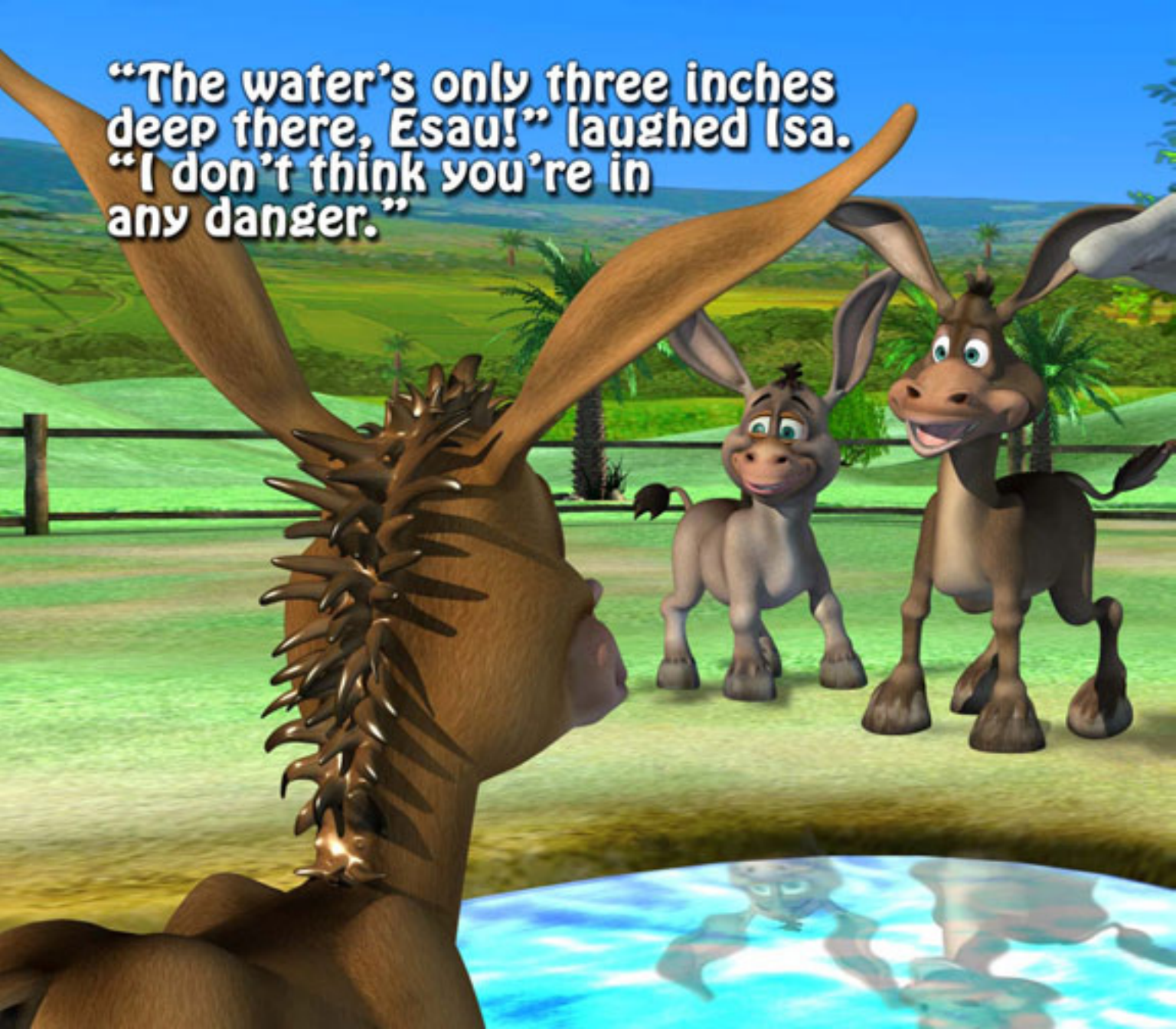


**“Hey look guys!

healing people.”**

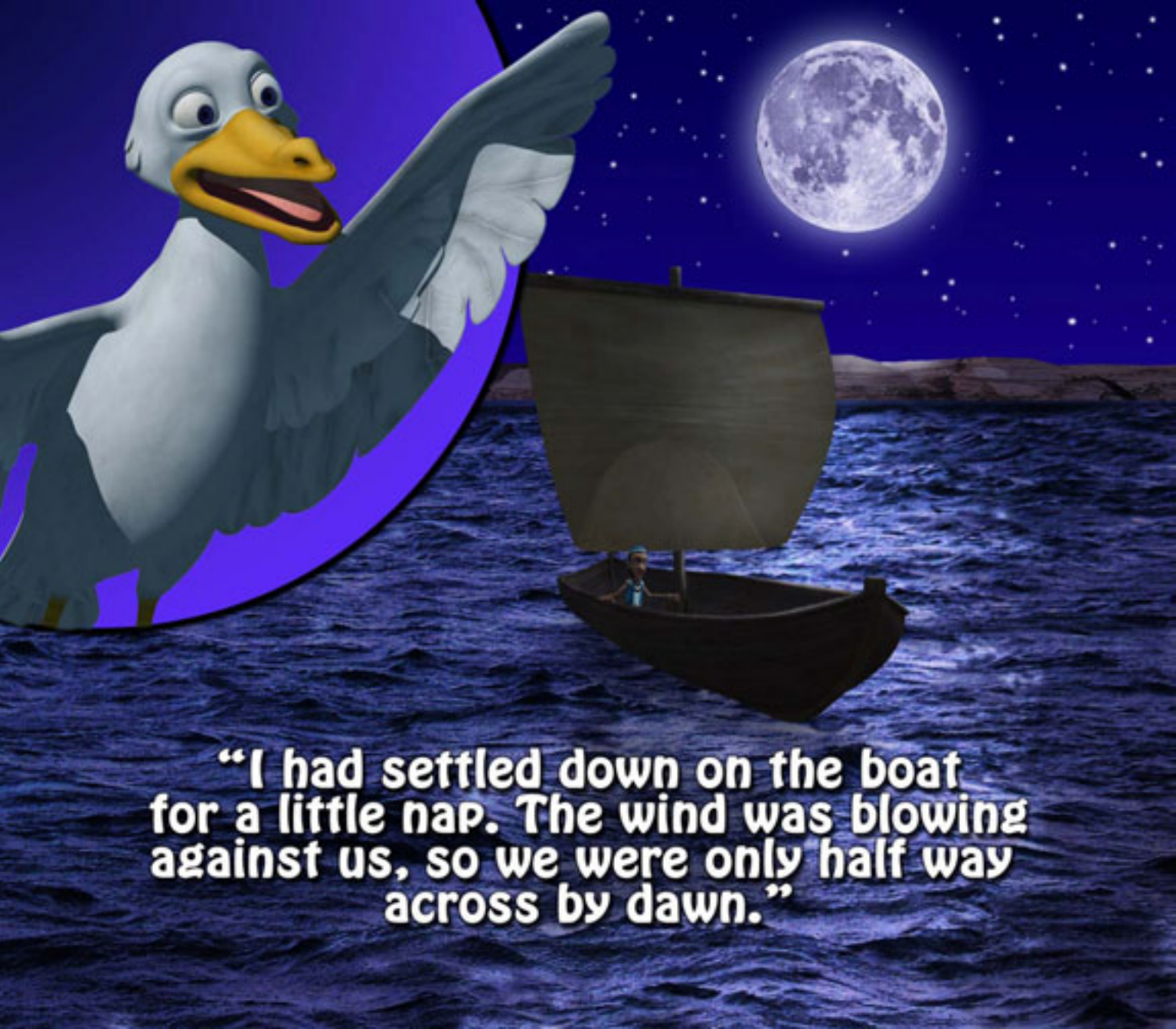

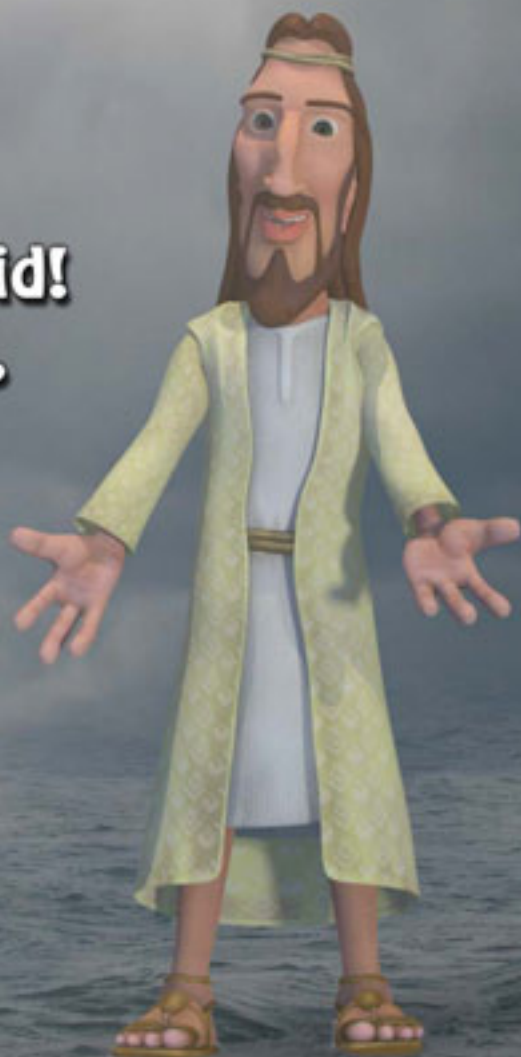




**“Peter got out of the boat and walked over to Jesus. Then suddenly, he got scared and began to sink.”**

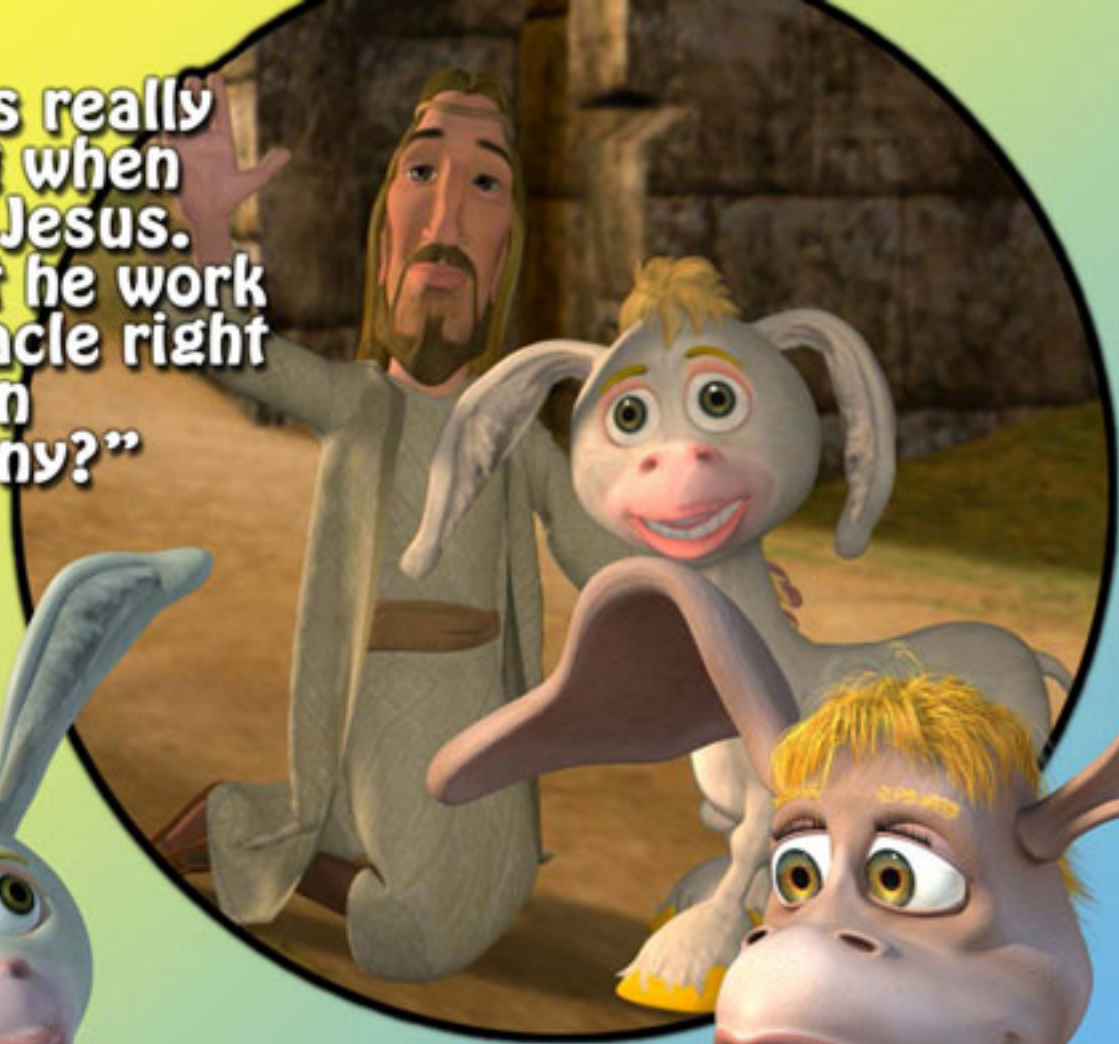
**“Are you all right,




